

**Subject:** **Vehicle Damage-Downtown Business District**

On January 11<sup>th</sup> 2024 and January 12<sup>th</sup> 2024, Elmira Police Officers responded to the Downtown Business District for 7 reports of damage to parked vehicles. Investigation found that vehicles were damaged in order to gain access to the passenger compartment and steal personal property within. Victims incurred a combined total loss of \$3,768.12 in property damage.

On February 7<sup>th</sup> 2024 the sole suspect in these reports was located by a uniformed Elmira Police Officer and fled on foot. Terry Roupp Jr, a 43 year old Elmira resident, was subsequently located and taken into custody without incident. He remains in Elmira Police custody awaiting arraignment in Elmira City Court.

Terry Roupp Jr is charged with multiple offenses including:

Criminal Mischief in the 2<sup>nd</sup> Degree, a Class D Felony (1 Count)

Criminal Mischief in the 3<sup>rd</sup> Degree, a Class E Felony (2 Counts)

Criminal Mischief in the 4<sup>th</sup> Degree, a Class A Misdemeanor (2 Counts)

Petit Larceny, a Class A Misdemeanor (1 Count)
